The Solemnity of Sts. Peter and Paul

Peter and Paul are the principal patron saints of Rome. They are also the most famous persecuted by Emperor Nero from 64 A.D. to 68 A.D. Saint Peter was one of Jesus' original twelve Apostles and the first Pope. Peter was a Jewish fisherman before he was called to be an Apostle. Jesus changed his name from Simon to Peter ("Rock") and gave Him the keys to the kingdom of Heaven (Matthew 16:19), and is often shown with keys.

Saint Paul (originally Saul) was a young anti-Christian Pharisee. When the Resurrected Lord appeared to Him on the road to Damascus, he converted (Acts 9:1-9). From that point, he evangelized throughout the Mediterranean from the Holy Land to Spain. He is known as the "Apostle to the Gentiles" (nations). Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI said: "together [Sts. Peter and Paul] represent the whole Gospel of Christ."

A Letter of Introduction from Fr. Nicodemis Muithi

The Catholic Diocese of Kitui is in the East of Kenya covering about 19,000 square miles. As per the 2019 Census Report, Kitui has a total population of 1,136,187 million people of whom 20% are Catholic. The Diocese falls under the Arid and Semi-Arid regions of the country. Most of the residents of the Diocese are small scale farmers practicing subsistence farming.

I am 48 years old and was ordained a priest of Kitui Diocese on December 9, 2005. I attended a seminary in Kenya from 1997-2004. My father is 71 and my mom is 68 and are living in Kitui, Kenya. We are 9 children in our family and I am number one. There are 4 boys and 5 girls, the youngest is 24.

I arrived in the United States on May 31, 2023 to serve Christians of the Peoria Diocese and I am happy to have been assigned to your parish. I thank Father Joe and all of you for the warm welcome and I look forward to proclaiming the word of God together.

Let us keep the Faith and Pray daily so as to continue receiving God's favor. Edwin Harvey said "A day without prayer is a day without blessing, and a life without prayer is a life without power." Prayer unlocks many things. I will pray for you daily. Pray for me, too.
