

A young successful executive was traveling through a neighborhood street, going a bit too fast in his new car. He was watching for kids darting out from between parked cars

Too shook up for words, he watched as the boy pushed his brother up the sidewalk towards home. As he walked to his car, it was clear the damage was very noticeable, but he never bothered to repair the damage. He kept the dent as a reminder of this message: "Don't go through life so fast that someone has to throw a brick at you to get your attention."


