#### **MONTHLY DEDICATION - OCTOBER**

The month of October is dedicated to the <u>Holy Rosary</u>. The Memorial of Our Lady of the Rosary is celebrated on October 7.

In October 2002. St. John Paul II wrote the Apostolic Letter *Rosarium Virginis Mariae* (the Rosary of the Virgin Mary)."

This letter introduced five new mysteries, called the Luminous Mysteries or Mysteries of Light highlighting:

- 1. Jesus' Baptism in the Jordan
- 2. Jesus' self manifestation at the wedding of Cana
- 3. Jesus' Proclamation of the Kingdom of God, with the call to conversion
- 4. the Transfiguration, and
- 5. the Institution of the Eucharist.

Try to make a concerted effort to pray the Rosary together as a family during the month of October, read the Apostolic Letter to understand the beauty of this devotion more deeply, and pray the Luminous Mysteries.


