RE: KITUI MISSION APPEAL ON JUNE 22/23 AND 29/30, 2024.

Greetings and the Peace of Christ from Christians of the Catholic Diocese of Kitui, Kenya. Thank for having Fr. Nicodemus in your parishes. He is from our diocese and his priestly education was sponsored by a family in St. Marks Catholic Church, Peoria Diocese.

Kitui is a mission diocese covering 1900 sq. miles, with 35 parishes serving 1.2 Million people. The diocese is in Arid and Semi- Arid region of the Country, where one of the greatest challenges is drought and famine. For the last five (5) years the region has not received any meaningful rainfall. Poverty level stands at 65% with malnutrition at 52%. The main source of livelihood is subsistence farming: crops and livestock, but due to recurrent drought there is frequent cycle of famine making many people rely on the Government, Non- Governmental Organizations and the Church for relief aid. The trickle down effect of this influences everything including education, since schools close due to lack of clean water and the fees for tuition are redirected to buy food since the crops fail.

Your support during this mission appeal will bring hope to many people in Kitui. The funds will be used for the following:

- 1. School Fees for our Eighty-Nine (89) Seminarians
- 2. Youth and Pontifical Missionary Childhood Formation and Evangelization
- 3. Humanitarian Support to Vulnerable Children and Families
- 4. School Fees for Needy Students in the Diocese
- 5. Support to our Water, Health and Agriculture Projects
- 6. Support to St. John Eudes Rehabilitation Centre for Street Children





HOLY FAMILY IN LINCOLN

May 18, 2024

Dear sisters and brothers in Christ.

As we celebrate the great Solemnity of Pentecost, we recall the outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon the apostles and the birth of the Church. This gift of the Holy Spirit continues to be poured out upon the Church and upon us. I chose Pentecost intentionally as the day when we reach an important milestone in our two-year Growing Disciples planning process with the announcement about our parishes and churches. Thank you for your participation, your feedback, and your advice which have helped me make the decisions that are announced today.

I spent time in further prayer, study and discernment over the recommendations that were made to me by the extensive process of consultation which occurred. I have reached the following decision regarding Holy Family, St. Mary, St. Patrick, and St. Thomas Aquinas.

Holy Family in Lincoln, St. Mary in Atlanta, St. Patrick in Elkhart, and St. Thomas Aguinas in Mt. Pulaski will be merged into one parish with a primary worship site at Holy Family in

Fr. Joseph Dondanville will remain your pastor. Fr. Nicodemus Muithi will remain your parochial vicar

The implementation phase will begin in all parishes on July 1, 2024. The process of implementing this change is expected to be completed over the next 36 months. In order to adapt to this merger of parishes, it will be necessary to determine the new Mass schedule. I ask you to work with your pastor to arrange a schedule of four weekend Masses between the churches of the parish. I also ask you to study the churches in Atlanta, Elkhart, and Mt. Pulaski to determine which are the most viable and which may be consolidated.

I am asking every parish to engage in a process of renewal. Every parish is asked to evaluate its schedule of Masses, its programs of pastoral care and evangelization. I challenge every parish to be more intense in cultivating disciples. More information about this call to become a more vibrant parish will be released in the coming months.

I ask for your continued prayers and continued cooperation as we work together to strengthen and renew our Diocese in this new apostolic age. Know that I pray for you daily May the Holy Spirit bless all our efforts to Grow Disciples.


